The exam boards have a set of rules which all students must follow when taking their exams.

These rules cover:

Before the exam

You need to know which exams you have been entered for, and when they take place

During the exam

You need to know the rules you need to follow in the exam room

After the exam

You need to know when and how you will receive your results, and what to do if you think an error might have been made with your grade(s)

Before the Exam Period

You have been provided with information about the exams you are taking this summer in the form of a **Candidate Statement of Entry** and an **Exam Timetable**.

You must check these documents for:

- Accuracy. Tell the exams officer if:
 - you think we have been entered for an incorrect exam or TIER
 - you have <u>not</u> been entered for an exam which you think you should be sitting
 - your personal details are incorrect
- Exam day arrangements
 - Be aware of the date, time and location (room) of all your exams /assessments
- Exam clashes
 - Ensure that know what to do if you have two or more exam papers timetabled at the same time (this is known as a timetable clash)

Contingency sessions

There are no exams taking place on the following days/sessions.

You are expected to be in school or make yourself available at these times in case they are used in the event of an emergency:

- Monday 2 June (All Day)
- Wednesday I I June (afternoon)
- Wednesday 25 June (all day)

Exam Expectations - before the exam

- Exam timetable know your times and locations
- Room / Row / Seat
- Ensure you have any equipment in a clear bag or pencil case

Remember:

- Toilet **before** the exam
- Water no label and clear bottle
- Coat / Bags when directed
- Mobile phones make sure switched off and placed into your Crew Tray in the morning as normal.
- All watches leave in bag or hand to invigilator





- Not following the instructions of an invigilator
- Disruptive behaviour in the exam room (including the use of offensive language)

What is malpractice?

Exchanging, obtaining, receiving, or passing on information which could be exam related (or attempting to)

Malpractice

- Bringing unauthorised notes, study guides and personal organisers into the exam room
- Mobile phone or similar electronic devices (including a memory stick, smartphone, watch/smartwatch, AirPods, earphones/earbuds)

- Writing/drawing offensive or obscene material
- Copying from sources without referencing (including the internet and Artificial Intelligence tools) and misusing technology
- Sharing, copying work or allowing your work to be copied



What are formal exam room conditions?



Formal examination/exam room conditions are:

- Not talking to other candidates
- Not disturbing other candidates
- Not communicating with other candidates
- You are under formal examination conditions from the moment you enter the exam room in which you will be taking your examination(s) until the point at which you are permitted to leave
- If you talk to, disturb and/or communicate with other candidates as you enter or leave the exam room (as well as the whole time you are in the exam room), this is malpractice and will be reported to the awarding body who will decide whether to penalise you which may include disqualification

Invigilators

- Each exam room will have at least one invigilator
- Awarding bodies insist that invigilators must follow strict rules and regulations during exams
- Invigilators must record any irregular incidents which occur in the exam room (e.g. if someone feels unwell, requires the toilet or falls asleep etc.)
- If you behave in a suspicious manner the invigilator will approach you and ask you to stop
- If you misbehave, the invigilator will warn you that you may be removed from the exam room
- You are committing malpractice if you do not follow the invigilators instructions







Leaving the Room & Water Bottles



Leaving the Room

- Allowed Rest Breaks, known medical issues or exceptional circumstances only
- Cannot leave for the first 45 minutes or last 15 minutes
- It is not accepted practice to go to the toilet in Examinations.
- Go beforehand and manage yourself
- Stay for entire length of the exam

Water Bottles

- Clear no words or labels
- Water or Light Squash only

Emergency Evacuation of the Exam Room

Do not communicate with anyone



You must always follow the instructions of the invigilators

• If you have to evacuate; you must remain silent until allowed back in.

You will be given extra time to complete the exam



Exit from the Sports Hall

- Silence until you have left the exam room
- Chat on the way out has to be reported
- Dismissed row by row follow the instructions of the invigilators
- Pick up any items handed in.
- Go to where you are supposed to be!

- In an exam Check the screens. You will get a break!

Afternoon Exams

Go to the Toilet!

Exactly the same expectations as the morning.



At the end of the exam in the afternoon

When the afternoon exam is finished

- You may go home or
- Wait in the Atrium until your bus

Please don't wander around site

If you're **not** in an exam - you leave at the end of the day as normal.



Timings of the day

Once the exam period starts

Your school day will revolve around your exams.

If you have no exam - you are in as normal including Registration

If you have exams - you finish when they do. - This may be after 1500!

We may "move" some lessons around to help you revise or provide workshops before examinations



During the Exam period

- Breakfast and teachers will be available from 8am in the morning for all exams
- Period 6 Sessions will be adjusted to reflect your exams
- We will run revision sessions where appropriate before exams
- Between exams you students will be in 'normal lessons'
- Teachers will determine how this time is used **bring revision resources**
- We expect high standards of attendance / behaviour / focus from you.



Kindness begins with the understanding that we all struggle.




