### What are peripatetic music teachers?

Peripatetic music teachers teach in schools on a freelance basis, offering specialist, good value music tuition on an individual basis or in small groups. Lessons are usually during the school day, but may occasionally be after school where demand is high. Whilst the school helps to facilitate the lessons by providing teaching space and arranging for students to leave class to have their music lesson, the contract and payment is through direct contact between parent/carer and the teacher.

Having private lessons will allow your child to explore instruments they are keen to learn to play and to develop their love of music, technique and repertoire.

All our peripatetic music teachers have an enhanced DBS check.
